The Auburn Knights' Challenge is an all-day tournament at Auburn High School. This event is made up of two separate tournaments: a high school tournament for freshmen and sophomores will be held on site at the same time as our middle school tournament. High school and middle school teams will not play each other, and will play in different sections of the building. We will have two teams at the tournament. That means we have only twelve open spots for players, which I will fill on a first-come-first-served basis. Email me by Tuesday, February 6 to make sure your player has a spot at the tournament.

This tournament will take all day. We will have an opening meeting around 8:30am, and will start playing around 9:00am. Players must be present for the opening meeting at 8:30am. We will likely be done playing before 4:30pm. Students will need to be transported to and from the tournament by parents or in parent-coordinated carpools. Contact me if you want your player to attend and need help organizing transportation. You are welcome to leave your player with me during the day. You are also absolutely welcome to stay and watch the tournament, but must remain completely silent during all games and may not speak with players, whether they are playing or not, while games are going on.

This tournament will have two sections: the morning rounds before lunch and the afternoon rounds after lunch. We will likely play about five rounds in the morning and about three or four in the afternoon. In between the morning and afternoon games, players may leave for lunch with their parents or order food to be delivered to the tournament (address above). I will be at the tournament during lunch, so players who bring lunch or have it delivered are welcome to eat together on site. After the last morning round, the tournament organizers will tell us when the first round after lunch will begin; players who leave for lunch must return at least ten minutes before that time so that they are ready to play when the afternoon rounds begin.
